The Alliance Rotary Club is sponsoring a "FLY THE FLAG" project on five of the national patriotic holidays:

MEMORIAL DAY FLAG DAY 4TH OF JULY
LABOR DAY VETERAN'S DAY

The Alliance Rotary Club, assisted by Boy Scouts, will place a flag in your front yard the morning of each holiday and pick it up at the end of the day. An 18" plastic pipe will be buried in your front yard permanently, flush with the ground, to hold the flag staff. A plastic cap will cover the holder when not in use. The 3'x5' flag on a 10' shaft will be placed in the plastic pipe.

The cost for this service will be \$20.00 per year. Profits, shared with the Scouts, will be used to support local youth, community and international Rotary projects. These have included annual support of the, YMCA summer camp, YWCA special projects, Pegasus Farm, Youth Foreign Exchange program, United Way, annual Christmas party for handicapped youth, International Polio-Plus Campaign (eradicate polio from the face of the earth), etc.
